THE 4 LEGS OF LEGACY BUILDERS



- 1. Local Community Support and Outreach
 - 2. World Partnerships
- 3. Church Planting and Campus Development (including Training and Equipping)
- 4. Ministry Centre and Arena Ministry School

We take the picture of a 4 legged chair. The legs provide purpose to the seat and act as a stable foundation! Much like our Legacy Builders Ministry which provides 4 key areas we give into. These provide a framework for us to intentionally give into the following areas:

1. Local Community Support and Outreach

Sowing locally to alleviate poverty and to support the most vulnerable, broken and often most disenfranchised communities and people.

- Across the East Midlands region and into France,
 Toulouse we provide relief from poverty and hardship
 through foodbanks and clubs, hot meals, clothing, white
 goods and furniture. Serving people's basic needs. We
 partner with over 50 agencies, have a volunteer and
 staff team of over 80 people each week and serve
 over 5000 per month in Belper, Ilkeston, Mansfield and
 Nottingham.
- Partnering with local agencies to serve people in prison and those who are homeless through washing, shower and laundry facilities. Accommodation is offered through houses and sleeping bags and tents are made available too.
- Serving children in schools and working with social services and others to provide uniforms, meals, children's clubs, clothes and support for the families.

2. World Partnerships

Sowing into key relationships with men and women who are serving in other countries and continents in church planting, serving the poor, work amongst children and training.

Many of our partners serve in very complexed and difficult contexts. Some of these suffer discrimination, abuse and danger for the sake of the gospel. They rely on our prayers and support to carry the love of Jesus to the ends of the earth.

ALBANIA

The worker we support here is Rachel Wilson. Rachel has sowed into this nation for over twenty years, particularly with a heart for Children's ministry. Seeking to see an emerging generation know the good news of Jesus.

GREECE

Fakhrodin and Rodica Shafaati have recently relocated from Germany to the Greek city of Thessaloniki. Their desire is to reach Iranians no longer living in their homeland. Here is a large Farsi-speaking community they will be able to minister to.

FRANCE

Patrick and Lucile Nana-Gassa Gonga – A Campus of Arena Church but also a missions context. They are believing for a great prevailing church to emerge in Toulouse in SW France.

OPEN DOORS

Open Doors is an international ministry supporting persecuted Christians and Churches worldwide. Numbers of whom have to live out their faith in secret. Our heart in pray and giving is to express solidarity with those found in these immensely challenging situations.

KENYA

Some years ago Arena Church cemented a relationship with Compassion International. This has enabled many people in the church to sponsor a child by monthly contribution. The young people are based in Mugumo Village in Kenya, and we believe each one will fulfil their Godordained destiny in life.

ROMANIA

Here we partner with Pastor
Ghita Ritisan, the founder
and leader of APME (External
Pentecostal Missions Agency)
one of the fastest growing
missions groups in the world
over the last decade, with now
over seventy full-time workers
in many varied contexts.

NAMIBIA

Sandu and Marinela Maghiar are a young couple with two children who are Romanian yet following God's call to the African nation of Namibia. They are particularly involved in Church Planting and Christian Education.

SLOVAKIA

Pastor Stefan Pap is a long standing associate of Arena Church. Stefan's passion is Teaching and Training. He travels many thousands of miles each year to numbers of Eastern European nations. At this time he is particularly helping Roma Community church leaders.

3. Church Planting and Campus Development (including Training and Equipping)

To finance the planting of new campuses and churches through Arena Church and our Moving Forward Partnership. The greatest form of evangelism and kingdom influence in our world is through the planting of new churches. Millions of people have never heard.

- Planting, supporting and establishing of the 4 new campuses in Belper, Ilkeston (Hub), Nottingham and Toulouse, France. Continued financial support for the pastors and the outreach ministries.
- For a war chest to develop so that we can again plant more campuses across the East Midlands (5.2 million people) and other campuses in Toulouse, France (1.2 million people France's 4th largest city)
- Moving Forward Partnership presently as of 2023 we have 13 churches in partnership with Arena Church. Into our future as we work together we would like to see more churches planted and ministries birthed from this relational group that we could invest into.

Training and Equipping

To identify, train, equip and resource leaders and ministers to be influential in their worlds.

The passion is to train, equip and release people to become Kingdom Influencers in every area of their lives.

4. Ministry Centre Building update

A building was purchased in Ilkeston in 2019 that we are converting into a ministry centre that will enable further training of Ministry Leaders and Pastors. This building will also enable us to train and equip many more in the work of the ministry. It will now also provide a home for our Community Ilkeston Hub and Ilkeston Foodbank.

This is the work that has been completed so far:-

New Roof and Guttering	£19,518

With the ever increasing costs it is estimated that the cost to complete the building will be around £85,000 which includes electrics, plumbing, heating, flooring, building a kitchen area, storage areas, all sanitary ware, new disabled toilet.

We are thankful for the thousands of pounds that are saved through the work of volunteers but there are certain key areas which we do need the necessary trades for. We are also speaking to various businesses to help provide their financial support or business expertise to complete the building whilst also applying for funding through our volunteer funding team.

We set a goal of £105,000 and we saw £64,783 given even in the midst of the uncertainty of financial markets and cost of living crisis. £10,000 of this money was given to meet a specific need which is beyond these four areas of giving.



SO NOW TO TODAY

Our desire is always to seek to apply passion and vision into the outreach and ministries around Arena Church and Community. With our Legacy Giving we can see further, reach wider and continue in our mission to *go, grow, love and serve our world*.

In 2023, our year of 'WE GET TO' we are thankful that we get to partner together again in our Legacy Fund; to do above and beyond what is possible because of your giving. As we do what we can we trust God will do what only HE can.

This year we again are looking to give into our 4 key areas:-

2. Arena Ministry Centre and School

Whilst continuing to work with volunteers, local businesses and our funding team to complete this building project, which we are hopeful can provide towards the cost to complete; we require around £58,000.

The building will be used for our Ministry School - training leaders of today and tomorrow, leaving a legacy for decades



to come. The building will also be used to create a ministry base for our community along with portable offices; we will be launching Care for a Coffee in Ilkeston, running Kids and Seniors events and housing our ever growing media ministry and team.

3. Community Outreach

This support will provide the financial resources needed for launching after school programs and Care for a Coffee in Ilkeston, Shower Hour and laundry facilities in Nottingham and seed money to launch Supported Living accommodation at our Mansfield Campus. Whilst establishing the ongoing Parent and Tots work in Belper, we are hoping to be able to further develop our work with schools. Whilst this work will exceed our Legacy giving we seek to invest £24,000 through our Legacy 2023 Fund.

4. Campus Development and Future Church Planting

Our heart and desire is to start to raise a "war chest fund" that allows us to start planning and thinking about future church plants. Currently, this is not possible. However, with your Legacy giving we can start to plan further into areas we feel God is leading us into. We also wish to continue to invest into our four developing campuses (Belper, Nottingham, Toulouse and The Hub). This enables us to strengthen and support these campuses financially as they seek to grow.

We are believing for £40,000 to assist in this area

Your financial giving supports pastors, teams and ministry outreach costs.

A word regarding

CHRISTMAS GIVING

Whilst we endeavour to teach biblical principles regarding giving throughout the year we never aim to be constantly talking about money. To that end we take 2 special offerings through church each year; this giving is beyond our tithes and offerings.

1. Legacy

This is shared each year at our Vision Day.

2. Christmas Giving

Last year we gave away thousands of pounds through our Christmas giving for the most vulnerable, hurting and in need in our communities. Those who, without this extra giving, may not receive gifts and food at Christmas time. We will aim to launch this appeal in September/October which creates an opportunity for an additional offering to come specifically for Christmas.

This is because we have many local partners and businesses, who are not from a church background, who assist with our Christmas giveaways. Also for many, to think about Christmas giving in Spring time is just too soon. We want to always ensure transparency and this paragraph highlights this need which we will announce later in the year when more information will be available at that time.

What's the point of dreaming small? IF YOU'RE GOING TO DREAM, DREAM BIG!

Me, my family and our team have sown financially and sacrificially as have so many others. Will you continue to do so, but will others arise who may have not done so before? Frequently Asked Questions:

What is Legacy Builders in short?

This is an annual fund that we will look to create that will enable Arena Church to lay foundations and sow seeds into our future, creating a legacy for generations to come.

How can I get involved?

By prayerfully considering pledging or giving to this fund each year.

What happens if there is a surplus?

We desire to create a margin that would allow us to do so much more in these key areas. The more we give the more we are able to sow into ministry locally, nationally and across the world.

Who administers the fund?

The fund is administered by the Financial Team of Arena Church and the accountant auditors of Arena Church. It will be set aside as restricted funding for these areas only.

How can I give?

You can give weekly, monthly, annually or in whatever frequency you would like but please ensure when you give that you clearly mark on the envelope or on your online payment "Legacy" so that we can ensure this money is restricted for this purpose.

One off gift - £100 / £250 / £500 / £1,000 Monthly gift - £10 / £25 / £50 / £100 Business gift - £1,000 / £5,000 / £10,000

FAQ'S

Frequently Asked Questions:

Example:-

If 50 people gave £100p/m and another 100 people gave £50p/m we would see £120,000 given in one year!

The easiest way to give is to set up a standing order if you are able. The bank details for this purpose are:-

Can I Gift Aid on this amount?

Yes. If you are a UK taxpayer we can claim Gift Aid of 25%, which means £100,000 from UK taxpayers gives us a massive £25,000 extra! Please complete an online Gift Aid form at www. arenachurch.co.uk/giftaid.

Can I give through my business?

Over the years we have also had a number of business owners who have wanted to sow into the fund from their businesses. This is possible and a very efficient way of giving.

We are a registered charity and you are able to give from your profits to Arena Church Legacy Builders, thus making you more tax efficient.

This can be done weekly, monthly, or as a one-off. Please speak to your accountant or financial adviser for further guidance with this.

The generosity of businesses and business people has really swelled the fund and has helped us to achieve our goals. We love our business people and we are grateful for many who sow generously, knowing it's not just individuals but also businesses that are making a difference.
