In the 1800's a church pastor called Charles Spurgeon built a significant church in London that then influenced many through bible colleges, church planting and teaching resources but it all started in a "boiler room".

In the basement of the church he founded were literally hundreds of people praying every day. The boiler room is never glamorous and is usually unseen. But without the boiler room a house is starved of heat and will ultimately grind to a halt. Spurgeon understood the need to fuel prayer in his church and ministry as this was the source of power.

Prayer is a "boiler room". This Prayer Journal is written to be a helpful guide, a sharp tool in the ministry of prayer! Use it as your personal guide, make notes, write in it. Let it be a living book/notes.

We desire to see people praying, calling out to God. Pursuing him, establishing a loving relationship with a loving Father. We also want to fuel "the many boiler rooms" of prayer within Arena through Upper Zoom, groups, prayer walking and more.
