Protected by Trustees


The board of trustees bring their considerable marketplace wisdom, skills and expertise to appropriate legal and financial governance to Arena Church.



TOTAL BAPTISMS IN 2024




Story from Janice

We believe that real life change happens in the context of authentic relationships, which is why we are a church made up of small groups.


Story from Irene

A previous Arena Ministry School attendee


I was part of the 2023 Arena Ministry School (AMS). Having attended Arena for just over a year, I felt God was calling me to attend.
