All church matters relating to accounts, spends, policy and organisation come to the Church Board for discussion and sign-off. The Community is managed by a separate Board of Trustees, each one of them passionate about community transformation. The Conferencing arm is the use of the buildings outside of 'church times'. The Conferencing Staff again are outstanding in their commitment and any profit here comes back into the work of the church.

All accounts are managed in terms of spend and cash flow on a weekly basis by our Executive Pastor Julie Turner and Finance Manager Violet Christopher. Regular reports are then submitted to both Board and Community Trustees respectively. We also have a very close working relationship with our external independent accountant and all accounts are audited and scrutinised annually, as well as submitted to the Charities Commission. If there are any questions at any time of the year, our Executive Pastor is available to seek to bring an answer. The demands upon being a credible local church in this day are huge, and rightly so. Arena Church understands that with great growth comes great accountability and we determine, by God's grace, to continue to rise to the challenge.
