All of this has allowed us, despite the aforementioned challenges, to continue to make progress. Six Arena Church Campuses and the reach through our Online presence have all continued to grow and have impact in our Communities. The demands upon being a credible local church in this day are huge, and rightly so. Arena Church understands that with great growth comes great accountability and we determine, by God's grace, to continue to rise to the challenge.

#### **Protected by Trustees**


The board of trustees bring their considerable marketplace wisdom, skills and expertise to appropriate legal and financial governance to Arena Church.





We have been involved with Arena for many years, as missionaries in Albania we were delighted to host several people who helped us serve our community. Several times Arena Church blessed us financially enabling us to do outreach to the children and young people. The church also provided money for a bridge over the open sewage canals in our community that meant people could safely get across to go to school, shops or friends.

When we first arrived in Albania, three amazing men from Arena (who didn't know us) drove over in a van with some of our belongings to help us make our home there. Towards the end of our ministry there we were so encouraged by a visit from Pastor Phil and Pastor Kristian who brought incredible encouragement.

Returning to the UK our sons went to Arena Youth. Then when lockdown happened, we joined Arena online, and we knew it was time to move to the church as a family. We started attending Mansfield, our most local campus and have been so welcomed and have been enabled to serve the church which is such an honour. As parents seeing your children thrive and grow in God is such a blessing and we have seen the difference Arena has made to our children.


# Story from Henry
