Paul- says Fight , Finish, Keep (to attend to carefully, take care of / to behold and observe without distraction to guard)

Second letter to Timothy its an epistle of encouragement to fight

- Fight for Truth , sound doctrine, loyalty to Paul, his team the gospel 1:14
- Fight for Purity 2;22

- Fight in a mixed up, messed up, ME obsessed culture 3:1
- Fight for Reality (put away hypocrisy, fakery, pretense) 3;5
- Fight in the midst of persecution 3:12

NOT EVERY FIGHT IS A BATTLE TO BE ENGAGED.

EQUALLY THERE ARE SOME BATTLES THAT MUST BE ENGAGED AND ENTERED INTO IF WE ARE TO PREVAIL IN THE LOCAL CHURCH.

3 ENEMIES

Common SIN. FLESHLY Desires. DEMONIC FORCES

Pick the right fights, Patient in the Fight and Anticipating the Fights

1. BE WISE IN THE FIGHT

Gen 3:1 serpent was more crafty than any of the animals God made. So interesting Jesus making a point when he says to those he's sending out

Matt 10:16 be as wise (crafty) as a serpent, but as harmless as a dove.

Wise, discerning, subtle, clever

Church life and leadership develop and train in wisdom, discernment, craftiness

How to be wise

A. Raise up PRAYER.

Elevate prayer, A mark, imprint, impression of prayer in church life A people of Prayer (teach them to pray and how to pray) A regiment of PRAYER (prayer guards, intercessors)

Surrounded in prayer.

B. Listen

Article Larry Stockstill "Listen to hear not to answer"

as you listen you will see, discernment will become yours.

- Listen to heart and mind.
- Listen to wise and trusted confidants and leaders.
- Listen to Holy Spirit
- Listen to spouse

2. Build Bridges where possible!!!!!

Some people we have are twisted, corrupt, and are wolves! But not always....!!!!!!!

Podcast recently Matt Chandler ACTS 29 eg in repurposing journey win over 2 elders. W/ meals coffees time etc.

IN A HURRY SLOW DOWN TO SPEED UP

3. WHERE and WHEN necessary FIGHT and HOLD YOUR GROUND.

(have an ally / armour bearer (not just wife))

Going into battle Motives keep in check / Offence (not an occupant)

Deal with Issues quickly.....!!!

Morality - Try to deal with privately. Don't fudge it will trip you up. If it becomes public then deal with it publicly. Be clear.

Theology / Philosophically - Foundational Truth or open to differences??? Is compromise possible?? Common Ground Disagree without separating???

Much of what spoils the church and hurts unity is petty differences, hills not mountains. Eg style, fabric, systems. WHAT CAN WE AGREE ON?

Identify the source of where something is coming from.... " Spoiled, hyper -emotional, hyper sensitive, argumentative, petulant, religious - super spiritual, prideful, controlling, rebellious, un submissive, aggressive, know it all, unteachable, " is IMPOSSIBLE to reason with. Needs a spiritual breakthrough.

Relationally - murmuring, complaining, gossiping more severe than we realize and so much more toxic than most!!!

recently reading and impacted by.....

"They traveled from Mount Hor along the route to the Red Sea, to go around Edom. But the people grew impatient on the way; they spoke against God and against Moses, and said, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? There is no bread! There is no water! And we detest this miserable food!" Then the Lord sent venomous snakes among them; they bit the people and many Israelites died." Numbers 21:4-6 NIV

Deal with these things in leaders and associates.

NB LEAD conversations with Grace and TRUTH follows

4. BE STRONG and COURAGEOUS

""But you, Israel, are my servant. You're Jacob, my first choice, descendants of my good friend Abraham. I pulled you in from all over the world, called you in from every dark corner of the earth, Telling you, 'You're my servant, serving on my side. I've picked you. I haven't dropped you.' Don't panic.
